

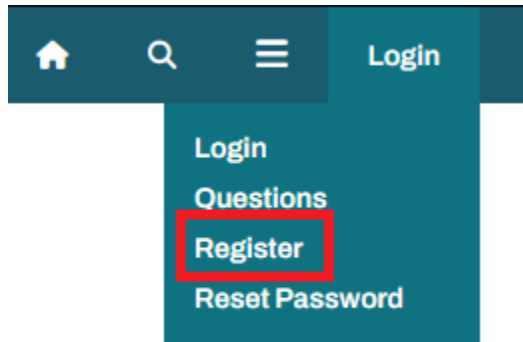

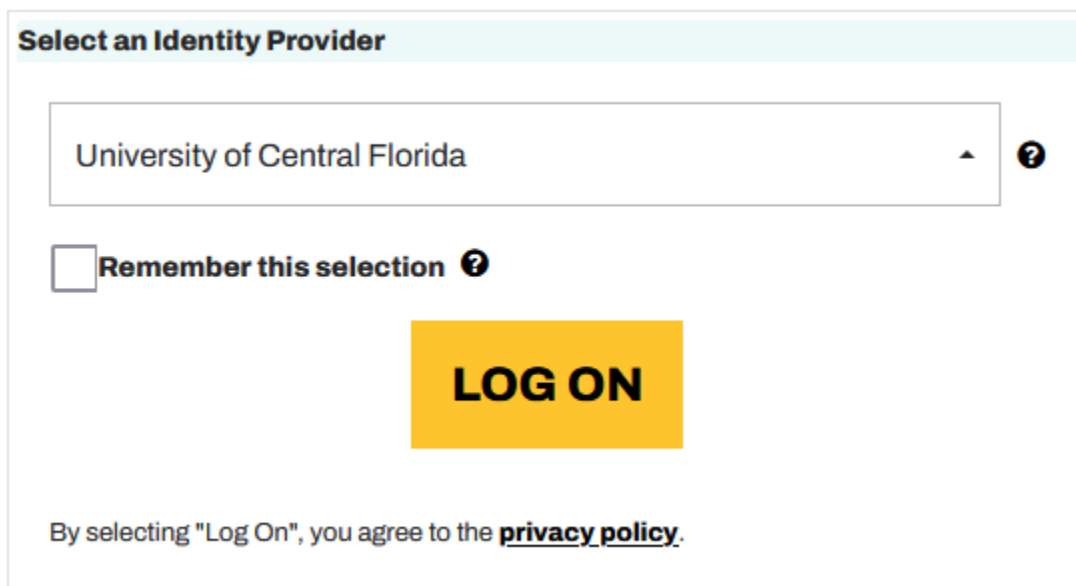
Navigate to <https://access-ci.org/>, and in the upper-right corner of the screen mouse over 'Login' to find 'Register'.



You will be led to <https://operations.access-ci.org/identity/new-user>. Important to consider, if you already have an XSEDE account (now ACCESS) then that identity will allow you to log in with the "ACCESS CI (XSEDE)" identity provider option.

Follow the steps for **Register with an existing identity**, which contains a link to <https://identity.access-ci.org/new-user-federated>.

Under **Select an Identity Provider** choose "University of Central Florida".
