
## **Account Creation for NSF ACCESS**


Navigate to <a href="https://access-ci.org/">https://access-ci.org/</a>, and in the upper-right corner of the screen mouse over 'Login' to find 'Register'.



You will be led to <a href="https://operations.access-ci.org/identity/new-user">https://operations.access-ci.org/identity/new-user</a>. Important to consider, if you already have an XSEDE account (now ACCESS) then that identity will allow you to log in with the "ACCESS CI (XSEDE)" identity provider option.

Follow the steps for <u>Register with an existing identity</u>, which contains a link to <u>https://identity.access-ci.org/new-user-federated</u>.

Under Select an Identity Provider choose "University of Central Florida".



When you click "LOG ON" you will be taken to a login portal for UCF, where you will login with your UCF account, NID@ucf.edu. Complete this process and you'll have an NSF ACCESS account linked to your UCF identity.

Finally, navigate to <a href="https://allocations.access-ci.org/profile">https://allocations.access-ci.org/profile</a>. As of Fall 2025, ACCESS requires users to fill out demographic information regarding the user's academic status, country of residence, and citizenship. Navigate to "Additional Information" in the profile link above and fill out your institution, academic status, country of residence, and citizenship information.
